




The **Middle East Poultry Expo** is the largest exhibition specialized in the poultry industry organized in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, which is the largest poultry producer in the Middle East and Africa and the third global consumer of meat and poultry products. The Middle East Poultry Expo 2023 was a great success with the participation of 207 exhibitors from 37 countries and the attendance of 10,000 visitors from 54 countries around the world. Riyadh will host the third edition of the Middle East Poultry Expo from 13 to 15 May 2024 on an area of 11,000 SQM at the Riyadh International Convention and Exhibition Center

Riyadh is the ideal place for businesses to access a thriving and rapidly growing market. The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is the largest Arab Gulf country in terms of area and population, and is the growing player in poultry farming in the Middle East, as the Saudi government is investing heavily in finding innovative solutions to regional challenges in poultry production and an innovative response to the everincreasing demand, and more than what the Kingdom produces alone.

represented by the Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture and the Agricultural Development Fund, provides unparalleled financing and support for the development of the poultry sector and the expansion of local production, as it provides financing of up to 70% of the capital in modern technology projects that include the poultry sector, as well as providing facilities in Granting government lands for projects. In this way, it seeks to achieve the goal of raising the self-sufficiency rate of poultry meat to more than 80% by 2025.





SAUDI ARABIA PLANS \$5BN INVESTMENT TO BECOME SELF-SUFFICIENT IN POULTRY MEAT PRODUCTION

Saudi Arabia plans **SR17** billion (\$5 billion) investment to boost poultry production as the Kingdom aims to achieve a poultry meat self-sufficiency rate of 80 percent by 2025, Saudi Press Agency reported.

By targeting 1.3 million tons of broiler chickens per year, the ministry will ensure national food security, increase local content, and create employment opportunities, the Saudi Minister of Environment, Water and Agriculture Abdulrahman Al-Fadley said.

This move follows a jump in self-sufficiency in poultry meat from 45 percent in 2016 to 68 percent in 2022.

275 POULTRY PROJECTS LICENSES IN 2022

The Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture announced the issuance of new licenses in the poultry production and breeding sector in the Kingdom, amounting to 275 new licenses. 119 licenses for broiler projetcs and 26 new projects to produce eggs with a production capacity of more than two billion eggs per year, and 12 projects to breed and produce broiler mothers and operate hatcheries with a production capacity of 480.5 million chicks per year.

The ministry added that this aims to develop the agricultural services sector and support agricultural production, expecting that these licenses will contribute to encouraging investment in agricultural production projects using modern techniques that guide water consumption, and the best agricultural practices adopted and approved, in line with the ministry's strategy and Vision 2030 to achieve food security, and in pursuit of Including in securing a distinct local product of high quality.

6 GOALS

Developed by the Ministry of Environment, Water and Agriculture. It was represented in increasing the number of licenses and expanding investment operations to increase local production and meet the increasing demand, achieve self-sufficiency, increase the size of the macro economy and attract new investors, create job opportunities for national cadres, empower women cadres in support services in the sector, and achieve rural development.

The **Middle East Feed & Mills Expo** is organized concurrently in time and location with the Middle East Poultry Expo. Local and international exhibitors share feed products and the latest technology in milling and grain processing.

The Saudi Arabia animal feed market was valued at US\$2,482.521 million in 2019 and is anticipated to grow at a CAGR of 5.64% to reach US\$3,450.535 million by 2025. Saudi Arabia is one of the fastest growing animal feed markets in the middle east region, increasing consumption of raw and processed meat along with the rising health consciousness among consumers are driving the demand for animal feed market in the country. Poultry feed segment is dominating the market since 2018 and is expected to be one of the fastest growing segment during the forecast period.

The Middle East Feed Minerals Market is projected to attain a CAGR of 4.5% during the forecast period of 2020-2025. Mineral Feed is generally a mixed feed that comprises of minerals for the nutrition of livestock enriched with vitamins, flavoring agents, and medicated ingredients. Mineral feeds involve liquid mineral feed which contains vitamins and mineral elements. These minerals help in maintaining the well-being of livestock and improve the growth of animals. The necessary elements which are not present in the body of animals are added to the feed to maintain the health of animals. The effect of disease outbreaks of livestock health has increased the importance of minerals in the feed of animals. Owing to this, there is widespread awareness about good quality meat products, which is thus likely to accelerate the usage of feed minerals in the compound feed industry in the years to come.




